

Amie was very organized and thorough with her daily lesson plans. She utilized manipulatives and various kinds of media and technology often in her lessons. Amie addressed different learning styles in her teaching by trying various techniques and approaches to learning like cooperative groups, charts/diagrams, and hands-on activities. She designed an integrated unit on the Earth, which incorporated different areas of the curriculum, including Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and some Math. The children responded well to the different tasks that Amie asked of them. Amie utilized various motivators to open her lessons and concluded all lessons with an appropriate closure. Her activities were age-appropriate and relevant to the concepts being taught.

Amie responded well to the children and tried to have each student feel success. She provided individual tutoring on math concepts over her planning time so that children having difficulty might learn. Amie got to know each student and cared for them. Her rapport with the students was very good, and they respected her as their teacher. Amie also had a good relationship with the parents of our students. She seemed very comfortable in the classroom setting and became a part of our faculty, as well.
